### **Vision and Mission**

The Technical Forum (TF) is a collaborative of technical experts who use independent professional judgment and a transparent, unbiased, technically rigorous process to develop and/or review energy measure parameters and other technical information related to the California energy efficiency portfolio, whose work is guided by efficiency experts on the Policy Advisory Committee (PAC), collectively referred to as the Cal TF.
