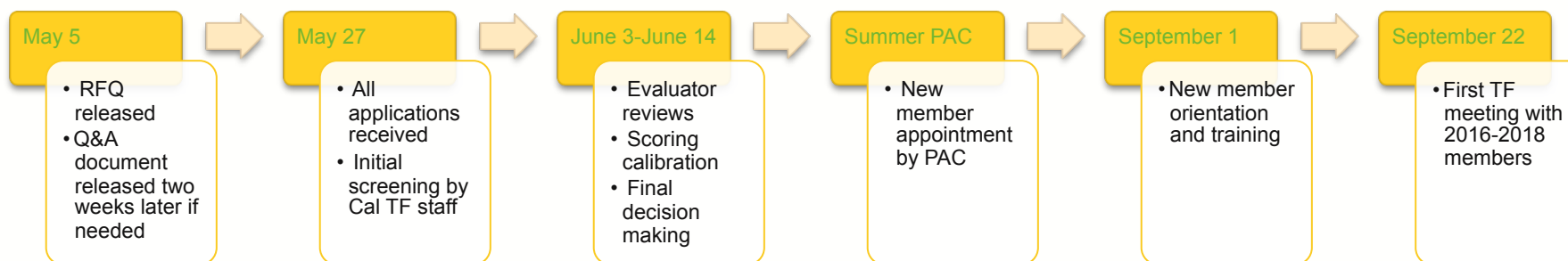
# Current Members

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- Nine members appointed in 2015 have terms that run through 2017
  - ❑ Goal of staggering member “classes” to ensure continuity
- Cal TF staff will send request to other members about whether would like to continue past June 1<sup>st</sup>
  - ❑ Will try to stagger appointments.

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# New Commitments for Participation



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- Close review of 2 peer review documents per year
  - ❑ Including measure workpapers and technical position papers
  - ❑ Utilizing “workpaper review” checklist to be developed by Cal TF staff
- In person attendance (for Cal TF Discussion):
  - ❑ 8 out of 10 meeting for California-based
  - ❑ 5 out of 10 meetings out-of-state
