- Will the data points highlighted by individual parties (i.e. Ecology Action's T-12 survey) be used to inform C&S impact evaluations?
 - Cal TF is limiting ourselves to preempting non-compliance via our workpapers.

- Were any of the trade allies able to quantify the amount of code noncompliance/deferred retrofits?
 - The answer to this question can arguably be both yes and no. There were no new, statistically robust studies submitted, but comments definitely highlighted the existence of potentially valuable pockets of data that fall somewhere in between ‘market assessments’ and ‘anecdotal.’
- Was there any discussion of how the current REA and preponderance of evidence standards are dissuading customer participation?
 - Yes. Not all of the issue is within scope of this subcommittee, but we do have some non-Code Trigger measures in our list that may help shed some light on that.
