- Structure:
  - Rate value of past work (numeric and room for comments)
  - Cal TF and PAC Process
    - What is working/what can be improved
    - Solicit input on changes to Cal TF composition
  - Solicit input on future direction
    - Mission
    - Objectives
    - Paste value of future possible work (numeric and room for comments)
  - Will separately report responses from different organizational types (assuming sufficient responses received in individual categories)
    - ▼ Cal TF members, implementers, IOUs, POUs, CPUC Staff/consultants, CEC Staff/consultants, Evaluators
  - Follow-up individual interviews, as needed.
