- **Custom Rulebook**

- Single, accessible, organized, clear, up-to-date, easy-to-understand, easy-to-navigate source for all custom rules
- Incorporate all new/updated rules through the Custom Rulebook
- Regular, transparent update process
- Establish as Rulebook for all Custom activities (project development, PA technical review, Ex Ante Review, and Ex Post Evaluation)

- **Work Product**

- **Resource:** Single, accessible, organized, clear, up-to-date, easy-to-understand, easy-to-navigate source for all custom rules
- **Process:**
 - ✦ **Updates/Maintenance** – incorporate all new/updated rules and guidance through the Custom Rulebook via a regular, transparent update process
 - ✦ **Communication** – communicate new/updated rules so stakeholders are aware of changes and relevant impacts
 - ✦ **Training** – training to support stakeholder awareness and understanding of rules

Develop Draft Rulebook – Q1

- **Consolidate**/organize policy, guidance, rules in one place
- **Categorize** policy, guidance, practice
- **Identify**/address clarification needs, conflicts

Crowdsource Stakeholder Input – Q2

- 
- Add missing guidance (e.g., from project dispositions/communications)
 - Identify clarification needs
 - Identify rules that may be problematic
 - Discuss format, navigability, maintenance, communication, training

Collaborate & Resolve – Q3/Q4

- Collaborate with stakeholders to clarify/resolve conflicts, address barriers
- Goal to have complete/resolved Rulebook by end of Q4

Custom Rulebook Workbook

10

- Custom Rulebook Workbook (CRW)
 - Identifies/consolidates rules relevant to stakeholders developing and reviewing **Calculated Custom** projects
 - Organizes, characterizes rules
 - Identifies root source of rule (law, policy, guidance, etc.)
 - Helps “flag” rules that need clarification/discussion
 - **Not** the intended format/layout of Custom Rulebook
- Link to CRW Module 1
 - Content for **Eligibility**

Field Name	Field Description
ID	Rule ID number for reference - do not change
Source	Source of Rule (see "Source List" on the right)
Rule Category	Cal TF Staff assigned each Rule to a Category to help organize the rules (see list on the right)
Rule Subcategory	Cal TF Staff assigned each Rule to a Subcategory to help organize the rules
Requirement	Indicates whether the rule is a CPUC requirement or PA-Specific requirement
Rule (Original)	Original text of rule taken from source document
Rule - Short Name	Short name for the rule (to help with quick identification and connect similar rules)
Rule - Description	Description of the rule (copied from original for adapted for conciseness, clarity, and/or combining similar rules)
Reference (Original)	Original reference (if available) for rule, taken from source document
Rule - Policy Reference	Confirmed policy reference if available, with relevant text
Rule Type	Cal TF assigned each rule a "Rule Type" based on reference information (see list on the right)
Cal TF Note	Cal TF Staff notes for review
CC or Custom	Indicates whether the rule is Cross-Cutting (CC) or specific to Custom measures
Recommended Location	<<ignore>>
PD	Indicates whether the rule is relevant to Project Developers (PD)
PA	Indicates whether the rule is relevant to Program Administrators (PA)
Clarify	Cal TF Staff flag that rule needs clarification
Problematic	Cal TF Staff flag that rule may be Problematic
Difficult/Expensive	Cal TF Staff flag that rule creates significant cost/challenge to custom project (development, review, etc.)
Tier	Cal TF Staff flag if rule should or could be Tiered (e.g., based on project or customer size)
	Stakeholder Input Fields:
Needs Clarification	Flag (with a "1") if Rule needs clarification (e.g., if language is inaccurate or unclear; has been interpreted differently by different stakeholders)
Problematic	Flag (with a "1") if Rule is problematic (e.g., creates significant barriers to EE and/or customer participation; inconsistent or in conflict with CA/CPUC EE goals, etc.)
Difficult/Expensive	Flag (with a "1") if Rule creates significant cost or difficulty in developing, reviewing, implementing custom projects (such that cost >>> value)
Tier	Flag (with a "1") if Rule could or should be Tiered (e.g., based on project or customer size)
Other Comments	Add any other comments you want to note/share.
