### □ Aug 1<sup>st</sup>

- ✦ All measures approved by CPUC were uploaded
- ✦ Measures planned but not yet submitted were upload (approx. 140)

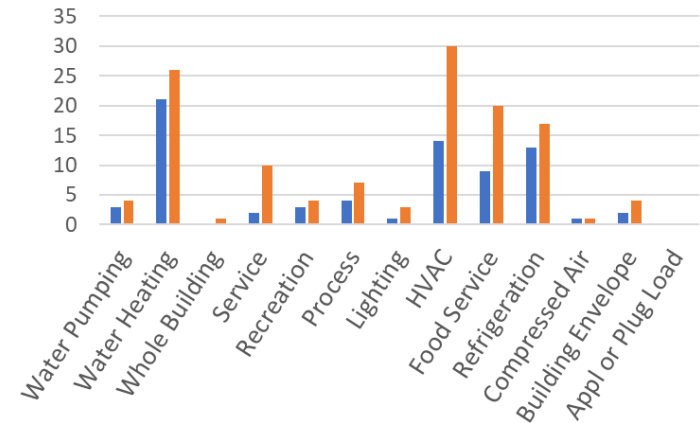
### □ Oct 15<sup>th</sup>

- ✦ Soft Launch of the eTRM
- ✦ All CPUC approved measures were QC'ed and *Published* (82 measures)

### □ Ongoing

- ✦ IOUs continuing to submit measures for 1/1/2020
- ✦ Measures Published on when they are approved by the CPUC
- ✦ Expecting about 140 measures available for 2020

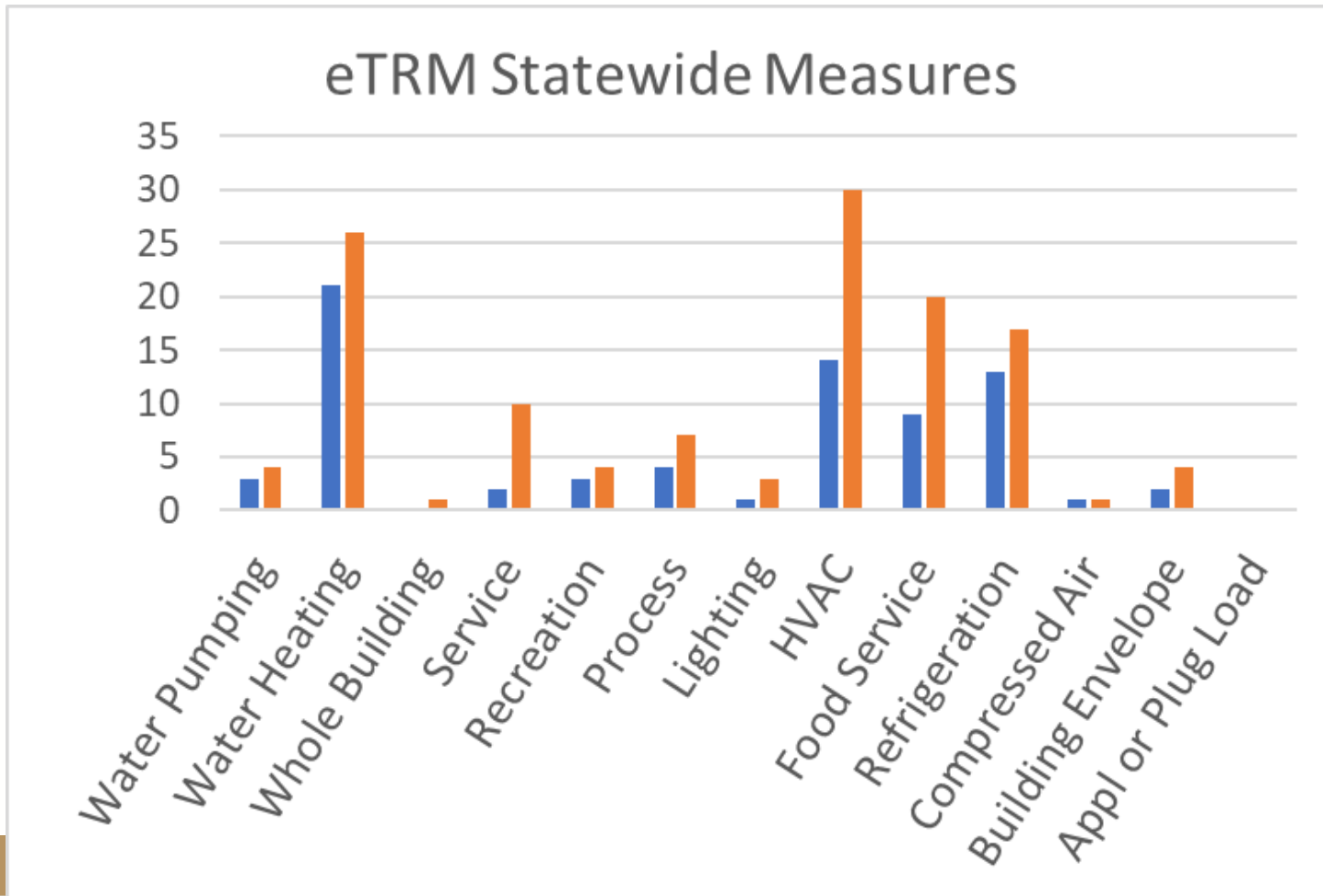

# Goal 2: Develop Stage 2 Issue Roadmap



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- TPP 9 – Deemed Measure Consolidation: Stage 1 and Stage 2 Issues
  - Completed: February 2019
- Completed more than 40 issues through 2019
- Planning for DEER 2022 Updates
  - EUL policy for AOE measures (*longer life*)
  - Missing EUL IDs for Host equipment (*missing information*)
  - AR guidance to all more existing conditions (*new measures*)
  - Defining existing conditions for AOE measures (*new measures*)



# Goal 3a: Manage the eTRM

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- Training objectives completed
  - Conducted training for core users
    - ✦ January 29 and January 31, 2019
  - Conducted two public training sessions
    - ✦ February 21 and March 4, 2019
  - Post-training survey
    - ✦ Feedback was very positive for content and ease of navigation

# Goal 3b: Manage the eTRM

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- eTRM enhancements identified and prioritized
  - List compiled during development and testing
  - Q1 2019: Vetted with funding parties
  - March 27, 2019: Charette with funding parties, developers, stakeholders
    - ✦ List was further clarified over subsequent months
  - October 1, 2019: List largely finalized



# Goal 4: Develop eTRM Transition/Leveraging Plan

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- eTRM Work Plan drafted and socialized
- eTRM Transition / Leveraging Plan drafted and discussed extensively with stakeholders
  - Plan will be circulated for comment by the end of the year

  - Statewide measure calculation approach classification
